The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Board Chair Mic VanDeVere, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. Commissioners present were Joe Drietz, Corey Sik, Jack Vizecky, and Mic VanDeVere. Absent was Commissioner Richard Hamer. Also present was Lincoln County Auditor, Deb Vierhuf and Lincoln County Attorney, Glen Petersen. No conflicts of interest were noted.

MSP to approve the consent agenda which included the minutes from January 2, 2018, and the agenda for January 16, 2018.

MSP to approve Policy P8 Road Reconstruction and Resurfacing as presented.

MSP to approve the Auto Cad training with an in-house trainer for \$6,400.00 and to extend a cost share training invitation to neighboring counties and other individuals that could use the training.

MSP to purchase a 2013 Side Dump Trailer for the Highway Department at a cost of \$44,500.00 plus tax, license and any other corresponding fees.

MSP to approve Resolution 09-2018 Corridors of Commerce.

MSP to approve the following Commissioner Warrants #6612 - #6674 for the following amounts: Revenue - \$100,741.57, Road & Bridge - \$39,373.79, Ditch - \$18,912.50, and Lake Improvement District - \$1,339.00.

PUBLIC MEETING INFORMATION
 The purpose of this meeting is to provide information about the proposed project and the state's review process, and to accept verbal or written comments on potential issues for the draft site permit that will be prepared. The Commission, Department of Commerce (DOC), and Blazing Star 2 Wind staff members will be available to answer questions.

PROJECT BACKGROUND
 Blazing Star 2 Wind Farm, LLC (Blazing Star 2 or Applicant) has filed a site permit application with the Commission for an up to 200 megawatt large wind energy conversion system (LWECs). The proposed LWECs would be comprised of 57 to 100 wind turbines ranging from 2 to 3.5 megawatts in size and associated facilities that include a project substation, an operation and maintenance building, access roads, meteorological towers, light range or sonic range detecting units, collection and feeder lines, and a temporary laydown area. Associated with this facility, but not part of the wind site permit application, is an approximately 7-mile 115-kilovolt (kV) high voltage transmission line (HVTL) and an approximately 1,000-foot, 345-kV HVTL. These facilities will be part

of a forthcoming HVTL Route Permit Application. The proposed LWECs project footprint would occupy approximately 57,800 acres of land located in Diamond Lake, Drammen, Ash Lake, Shaokatan, Royal, Hendricks, and Marble townships in Lincoln County, Minnesota.
